



Welcome to Pioneer Lakes RV Park. In order to make your stay more enjoyable and safe, we have set a few guidelines for all of our guests to have a safe and enjoyable stay.

- Please no bicycles after dark or before the quiet hour ends. Bicycle helmets are recommended. PA law requires children 12 years of age and under to wear helmets while riding bicycles.
- Please park and leave vehicles at your campsite during your entire stay, except to go to or from outside of the park.
- Motor bikes are permitted in the park, only to go from the campsite to outside of the park and back.
- Personal Golf carts are permitted with proper documentation and registration through the front office. The fee is \$50 per stay.
- It is strongly recommended that parents accompany all children 12 years of age and younger at all times.
- Children 16 years of age and under MUST be accompanied by an adult in the pool, at the pool deck, within the
 pool area fencing or near any water source at the campground at ALL times. Children that are unaccompanied
 will be asked to return to their campsite.
- Skateboards of any type, rollerblades, scooters, or roller skates are not permitted.
- Please do not move the fire rings. Fires are permitted in fire rings only. Please do not burn garbage, cans, etc. Please never leave a campfire unattended.
- · Washing of RVs and other vehicles in the park is not permitted.
- Pets are welcome! We ask that your pet remain on a leash at all times. It is strongly recommended that small
 children do not walk pets. Please pick up after your pet. Please keep in mind that the pet owner is responsible
 for any injuries their pet may cause. Please have all appropriate documentation for your pet available, should it
 be required.
- · Sorry, No swimming for pets, in the pool or lakes.
- Swimming in any of the lakes outside of rental boat usage is not permitted. Outside boats, kayaks, canoes, etc. are not permitted in the campground.
- Please be considerate of other campers, do not walk or ride bikes through fellow campers campsites.
- Controlled use of alcoholic beverages is permitted but restricted to your campsite only.
- Quiet hour begins at 11pm and ends at 8am.
- No firearms or fireworks are permitted at the campground (including 4th of July holiday)
- · Please do not cut or deface any trees.
- · Out of state firewood is not permitted
- Please do not feed the waterfowl. Geese, ducks, gulls etc. are wild animals and feeding them may create a dependency that is harmful to their health, upsets the natural cycles and may promote the spread of disease.
